Subject: Monitoring the safety, health effects and excess mortality of vaccines

Following up on the Commission's reply to a question¹ on the number of citizens inoculated against COVID-19 using vaccine doses, I request clarifications on some points.

The International Coalition of Medicines Regulatory Authorities (ICMRA) is not a relevant source for information on COVID-19 vaccine safety, health effects or excess mortality. I therefore request additional answers and data.

- 1. What exact scientific data, scientific report(s) or scientific publication(s) were the basis for the Commission's answer that 'no safety signal for increased mortality with any of the authorised COVID-19 vaccines has been identified by EMA to date'?
- What exact scientific data, scientific report(s) or scientific publication(s) are the basis for the assertion made in the Commission's answer that 'in fact, COVID-19 vaccines have saved millions of lives'?
