Subject: The situation of the Serbs in Kosovo

In a written question dated 14.4.2023¹, I asked the Commission about the Association of Serb-majority municipalities in Kosovo.

The establishment of this association was provided for in the 2013 Brussels Agreement²³.

'The European Union's special representative [...], Miroslav Lajčák, met representatives of the Serbian and Kosovar governments in Brussels on Thursday 16 November', but these discussions did not reach a 'breakthrough' on this point, according to Agence Europe⁴⁵.

Furthermore, 'the Kosovo Central Bank announced that as of 1 February, a Regulation of Cash Operations will enter into force [which] specifies that the euro is the only currency allowed for cash and digital payments in the country'6.

In addition, 'Serbian banks in Kosovo, Kosovo Serbs receiving pensions from Serbia, and employees of institutions that are still part of the Serbian system, such as schools and hospitals [...] use only dinars'7.

What action does the Commission intend to take on these two points, as well as in relation to the education and health systems of Kosovo Serbs?⁸
