

# Proposal for a regulation Recital 2

Text proposed by the Commission

(2) The European Union has by Council Decision 98/392/EC<sup>3</sup> approved the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea and the Agreement for the Implementation of the Provisions of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea of 10 December 1982 relating to the Conservation and Management of Straddling Fish Stocks and Highly Migratory Fish Stocks<sup>4</sup>, which contain principles and rules with regard to the conservation and management of the living resources of the sea. In the framework of its wider international obligations, the Union participates in efforts made in international waters to conserve fish stocks.

(2) The European Union has by Council Decision 98/392/EC<sup>3</sup> approved the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea and the Agreement for the Implementation of the Provisions of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea of 10 December 1982 relating to the Conservation and Management of Straddling Fish Stocks and Highly Migratory Fish Stocks<sup>4</sup>, which contain principles and rules with regard to the conservation and management of the living resources of the sea. In the framework of its wider international obligations, the Union participates in efforts made in international waters to conserve fish stocks and should strive for orderly and sustainable global ocean governance and fisheries management.

Fishing vessels shall ensure this information is transmitted within six hours of a sighting event taking place.
