1. Adoption of draft agenda¹

Referring to Rule 167 of the Rules of procedure of the European Parliament, MEP Auken requested to postpone the consideration of the draft report of the FFV to Catalonia, drafted in English (item 4 of the agenda) to the next Committee meeting so as to enable Members of the Committee to receive the draft report translated into other EU languages before its consideration.

On the same item, MEP Sanz Selva called for MEPs' linguistic rights to be respected and stressed that the report was sent on the eve of the meeting.

¹ In accordance with the committee's Guidelines 2016, items in sections B of the draft agenda will not be discussed during the current meeting. However any PETI Member may ask before the end of the meeting for an item in section B to be kept open; it will then be automatically included in the Coordinators' agenda for a decision on its further treatment at a subsequent Coordinators' meeting.

MEP Maestre Martín De Almagro supported the request to postpone the consideration of the draft report of the FFV to Catalonia and expressed concerns as regards the publication of the draft report in the press simultaneously with its dissemination to Members.

The request to postpone the consideration of the draft report of the FFV to Catalonia to the March Committee meeting was supported by MEPs Angel, Comín i Oliveres and García Del Blanco.

MEP Jahr stressed that the report was put in the agenda for consideration and not for adoption and underlined that the arguments put forward should not prevent Members of the Committee from holding a first exchange of views on the draft report.

MEP Toom reminded that the agenda foresaw only a presentation of the report, not an adoption. She stressed that all linguistic versions would be made available to make amendments before the set deadline. She added that interpretation was provided to enable the presentation and discussion on the draft report today.

MEP Danzi (NI) stressed that Coordinators decided not to follow-up her request to include Petitions No 0148/2020 and 1150/2019 on the agenda. She recalled that NI MEPs can either ask Coordinators to take their request on board for Coordinators' meetings agendas or pass their request for inclusion in future agendas during Committee meetings.

In reply to MEP Danzi, the Chair took note of the request to include Petitions No 0148/2020 and 1150/2019 on the Coordinators agenda.

On the objections raised by the other Members, the Chair reminded that, according to the European Parliament's code on multilingualism, Plenary documents and Committee reports which shall be adopted in Plenary have priority over all other documents for translation. Under Rule 228 of the Rules of Procedure on Fact-finding visits, mission reports are discussed and voted only in PETI Committee and not in Plenary. It is therefore long-standing practice in PETI to present the draft mission reports in English. Translations of the draft report are always provided before the deadline for amendments expires so as to allow all Members, in particular those who did not participate in the mission, to table amendments in their own language. The Chair recalled that the deadline for amendments was set on the 1st of March and indicated that translations in German, Polish, Italian and Spanish (the four languages of the Members who participated in the mission) would be provided the next day, on 15th of February, while translations in all other languages would be provided on the 27th of February.

The Chair also recalled that the Secretariat, on behalf of the Head of the delegation, had informed Members that the draft report would be prepared in English due to time constraints since there are only three Committee meetings left before the end of the term. The Chair underlined that the timetable was communicated a month ago and was not contested by any Member. Finally, the Chair clarified that the draft report was indeed sent the day before the meeting since the Members involved in the drafting did not finalise their negotiations on the draft earlier. The Chair also recalled that an IT version of the draft was prepared by the Secretariat.

In reply to MEP Auken's request to postpone the consideration of the draft report of the FFV to Catalonia to the March Committee meeting, the Chair noted that, pursuant to Rule 200(1) of the Rules of Procedure on adjournment of a debate or vote, the intention to move adjournment

shall be notified to the Chair at least 24 hours in advance. Since she was not notified in due time, the Chair rejected the request for adjournment as non-compliant with Rule 200(1) RoP.

MEP Auken asked for the Committee to take a decision on the Committee meeting agenda under Rule 216 RoP. Her request was supported by MEP Riba i Giner.

The Chair invited the Coordinators to decide on the approval of the draft agenda. EPP voted in favour, S&D voted against, Renew voted in favour, Greens/EFA voted against, ECR voted in favour and The Left voted against.
