 First part 'Considers that the digital euro will only become a success story if it provides tangible added value for European citizens that they can understand; notes that currently many European citizens either have not heard about the digital euro project or remain sceptical;'
 Second part 'invites the ECB, together with relevant stakeholders, to launch a broad information campaign on the digital euro in order to allay citizens' concerns;'

 First part 'Stresses that the EU's secondary objectives are indeterminate as currently specified by the Treaties;'
