Amendment

12a. Calls for all paramilitary groups, foreign armed rebels and mining-sector organised criminal gangs operating in the eastern provinces of the DRC to be disarmed; points out, in that connection, that a failure to do so fully, or at least substantially, before the next presidential and parliamentary elections, with the former set to take place as early as 27 November 2011, may undermine the still fragile peace and democratisation process in the country; warns, further, against any attempts to use the poor security situation in the eastern part of the DRC as a pretext to postpone or simply cancel these important elections, without which the DRC would not have a legitimate President, government and parliament in place;
