19. Is disturbed at the reports of the use of surveillance technology against Bahraini human rights defenders; reiterates that surveillance technologies exported by European companies to Bahrain could facilitate the repression of human right defenders; emphasises the need for the **EU** export control authorities to take human rights criteria into account before granting export licences to a third country; calls on all the Member States to **strictly observe** the EU Code of Conduct on Arms Exports, **and in particular to halt all** transfers of weapons, surveillance and intelligence equipment and material that can be used by Bahrain in its ongoing crackdown on human rights;

Is disturbed at the reports of the use of surveillance technology against Bahraini human rights defenders; reiterates that surveillance technologies exported by European companies to Bahrain could facilitate the repression of human right defenders; emphasises the need for the **competent** export control authorities to take human rights criteria into account before granting export licences **for dual-use goods** to a third country; calls on all the Member States to **follow the guidelines** of the EU Code of Conduct on Arms Exports, **including considering any** transfers of weapons, surveillance and intelligence equipment and material that can be used by Bahrain in its ongoing crackdown on human rights;
