

### Proposal for a regulation Article 11

Text proposed by the Commission

- 1. The specific additional allocation for the outermost regions shall be used to offset the additional costs, linked to the *handicaps* referred in Article 349 of the Treaty, incurred in the outermost regions in supporting:
- (a) the thematic objectives set out in Article 9 of Regulation (EU) No [...]/2012 [CPR];
- (b) freight transport services and start-up aid for transport services;
- (c) operations linked to storage constraints, the excessive size and maintenance of

The specific additional allocation for the outermost regions shall *not be subject to Article 4 and* be used to offset the additional costs, linked to the *characteristics and constraints* referred *to* in Article 349 of the Treaty *on the Functioning of the European Union*, incurred in the outermost regions in supporting:
- (a) the thematic objectives set out in Article 9 of Regulation (EU) No [...]/2012 [CPR];
- (b) freight transport services and start-up aid for transport services;
- (c) operations linked to storage constraints, the excessive size and maintenance of

- 4. Financing under this Article shall not be used to support:
