#### **Justice programme 2021-2027 \*\*\*II**

**European Parliament legislative resolution of 27 April 2021 on the Council position at first reading in a view to the adoption of a regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the Justice Programme and repealing Regulation (EU) No 1382/2013 (06834/1/2020 – C9-0138/2021 – 2018/0208(COD))**

**(Ordinary legislative procedure: second reading)**

*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the Council position at first reading (06834/1/2020 – C9-0138/2021),
  - having regard to the opinion of the European Economic and Social Committee of 18 October 2018<sup>1</sup>,
  - after consulting the Committee of the Regions,
  - having regard to its position at first reading<sup>2</sup> on the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council (COM(2018)0384),
  - having regard to Article 294(7) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
  - having regard to the provisional agreement approved by the committees responsible under Rule 74(4) of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to Rule 67 of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to the recommendation for second reading of the Committee on Legal Affairs and of the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs (A9-0146/2021),
1. Approves the Council position at first reading;
  2. Notes that the act is adopted in accordance with the Council position;
  3. Instructs its President to sign the act with the President of the Council, in accordance

with Article 297(1) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union;

4. Instructs its Secretary-General to sign the act, once it has been verified that all the procedures have been duly completed, and, in agreement with the Secretary-General of the Council, to arrange for its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*;
5. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the national parliaments.
