Invited by H.E Zainuddin Yahya, Head of the Mission of Malaysia to the EU and the Government of Malaysia in my capacity as a member of the Foreign Affairs Committee of the European Parliament, I took part in a fact finding mission to see and assess palm oil production in Malaysia and the efforts this industry has put in place with regards to its production to ensure sustainable development. During the trip we visited the United Plantations palm oil production site (located on peninsula Malaysia), visited the small holder supervision sit (located in the city of Kuching, in the region of Sarawak) managed by SALCRA (Sarawak Land Consolidation and Rehabilitation Authority), met with Regional Ministers, Deputy Chief Minister for Modernisation and Agriculture of Sarawak alongside other regional officials, met with backbench Members of the Malaysian parliament in Kuala Lumpur and also visited the Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB) headquarters in Kuala Lumpur to gain insight into technological advances in palm oil development, use in existing and new products and how such use is being brought to market in an environmentally sustainable way.
