Eurofin organizes annually two major international events (the High Level Seminar in March / April and the Financial Forum in September) gathering industry leaders and EU and non-EU public decision-makers for discussions on the major regulatory proposals in the financial area and the role of the financial sector in fostering growth as well as informal networking.

These events are regularly organized in association with the EU Presidency in parallel to the informal ECFIN councils etc. in some cases with the G20 Presidencies. They are organised with the support of 20+ State guests and 160+ participants.

These events are regularly organised in association with the EU Presidencies in parallel with informal ESDP Councils and, in some cases with the G20 Presidencies. They are also used with the support of UN Security Councils and other bodies.

Additional meetings involving the members of Eunavfor are set up to exchange views on regulatory issues.
