It is with pleasure that I write to invite you to the third high-level, public-private counter-piracy conference in Dubai, to be held on 11 and 12 September 2013. This year, the conference is entitled "Countering Piracy: An Ongoing Mission of Regional Capacity Building".

We are also working closely with our international partners to ensure all our efforts are aligned. Specifically, in order to build on the London Conference on Somalia of 7 May 2013, we will maintain a focus on capacity building in the region, including in the field of maritime security.

I am confident that, with your substantial support and participation, the UAE's high-level conference will contribute to further enhancing the world's collective response to maritime piracy. I very much hope that you will accept this invitation; therefore I am pleased to be able to offer you all necessary assistance in arranging your flight and accommodation during the conference.

I look forward to welcoming you to Dubai on 11 and 12 September 2013.
