- E. whereas, in the light of the negotiating process which culminated in the conclusion of a political agreement, it is *essential* that *the persons given the task of conducting negotiations should be issued with a political mandate by the committee(s) responsible and that the latter should be kept informed about the ongoing negotiations, if indeed the committee(s) does/do not choose the negotiating delegation and thus conduct the negotiations itself/themselves*, with a view to making *its/their monitoring work* as relevant as possible,
