Amendment 18 Recital 3

(3) **O**bjective, reliable and comparable information concerning drugs, drug addiction and their consequences is **required** at Community level to help provide the Community and the Member States with an overall view and thus give them added value when, in their respective areas of competence, they take measures or decide on action to combat drugs.

(3) Given the growing number of people who are coming into contact with drugs of all kinds, objective, reliable and comparable information concerning drugs, drug addiction and their consequences is becoming essential at Community level, to help provide the Community and the Member States with an overall view and thus give them added value when, in their respective areas of competence, they take measures or decide on action to combat drugs.

Justification

The European Union is currently unable to cope with the problem of the increasing number of

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people, including young people, who are taking drugs. There is therefore an urgent need for swifter exchange of information covering the problem as a whole, i.e. both drug taking and combating dependency.



- Each member of the management board shall have one vote, except for the representatives of the countries which have concluded agreements pursuant to Article 21 of this Regulation which don't have the right to vote.
- 1. The Centre shall have a management board consisting of *two representatives of the* Member *States*, two representatives from the Commission *and* two independent experts particularly knowledgeable in the field of drugs, designated by the European Parliament.

- 2. The Executive Committee shall meet at least twice a year and whenever necessary to prepare the decisions of the Management Board and to assist and advise the Director. It shall decide on behalf of the Management Board on the matters foreseen in the EMCDDA financial regulation which are not reserved to the Management Board by this Regulation. It shall adopt its decisions simple majority.
