# c) Detailed grounds for the increase

The additional amount will be for the closure of a commitment on line A03046 made in 2002 with non-differentiated appropriations. A recommitment must be made to allow payment of the balance of €51 920 due to a beneficiary under the terms of the agreement signed with him. The beneficiary correctly fulfilled his contractual obligations to the Commission, which is now obliged to pay him the balance mentioned.

The amount still available is for the projects chosen following the call for proposals VP/2004/12 in accordance with the financing decision on the line for 2004.

# c) Detailed grounds for the decrease

The amount allocated to this line comes from the total of former lines A0-2530 (Safety and Health Commission) and 2531 (Advisory Committee). This amount was also used to finance health and safety campaigns of the Safety and Health Commission. However, the new Advisory Committee was put in place this year, and groups are being set up gradually; we can therefore consider it as a start-up year. Furthermore, there will not be a health and security campaign in 2004, hence the amount not used. Requirements up to year-end were calculated on the basis of 75% utilisation compared with forecasts.
