## DRAFT EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION

**on the proposal for a Council decision on the conclusion of the Agreement between the European Community and the government of Canada establishing a framework for co-operation in the fields of higher education, training and youth  
(COM(2006)0274 – C6-0255/2006 – 2006/0096(CNS))**

### **(Consultation procedure)**

*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the proposal for a Council decision (COM(2006)0274)<sup>1</sup>,
  - having regard to Article 300(2), first subparagraph and Articles 149 and 150 of the EC Treaty,
  - having regard to Article 300(3), first subparagraph, of the EC Treaty, pursuant to which the Council consulted Parliament (C6-0255/2006),
  - having regard to Rules 51 and 83(7) of its Rules of Procedure,
  - having regard to the report of the Committee on Culture and Education (A6-0000/2006),
1. Approves conclusion of the agreement;
  2. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council, the Commission and the government of Canada.

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

There is a long tradition of cooperation in the field of education between the European Union and Canada.

This Agreement establishes a framework for cooperation in higher education, training and youth for the period 2006-2013. This Agreement renews the 2000 cooperation programme in higher education and vocational education and training, originally established under the 1995 Agreement establishing a cooperation programme in this area between the European Community and Canada.

This new Agreement between the European Community and Canada is in keeping with the Lisbon strategy which provided for education in the European Union to be made a world quality reference by 2010.

Having been specifically conceived to achieve the objectives of EU/Canada bilateral cooperation, this new agreement perfectly complements the programmes provided for under other Community instruments relating to education and training and the bilateral programmes between the Member States and the Canada.

Taking into account the evaluations made and the lessons drawn from past experience, it aims to renew, reinforce and broaden the scope of the previous agreement, providing a new framework for cooperation in the area of youth.

The programme would dispose of a budget of € 17.4 million over an eight year period and would aim, firstly, to improve mutual understanding between the peoples of the European Union and Canada, promoting a broader knowledge of their respective languages, cultures and institutions and, secondly, to improve the quality of human resources.

In order to attain these objectives, various different actions are envisaged. Actions focusing on higher education and training, in particular projects involving consortia aiming to execute joint study and training programmes and excellence mobility projects.

As regards youth, the actions would be focused in particular on youth structures and organisations aiming notably to promote dialogue, the exchange of best practices and the establishment of sustainable new multilateral partnerships and networks.
