

on the Council common position for adopting a decision of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the Culture Programme (2007-2013) (6235/3/2006 - C6-0269/2006 - 2004/0150(COD))

(Codecision procedure: second reading)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Council common position (6235/3/2006 C6-0269/2006),
- having regard to its position at first reading¹ on the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council (COM(2004)0469)²,
- having regard to Article 251(2) of the EC Treaty,
- having regard to Rule 62 of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the recommendation for second reading of the Committee on Culture and Education (A6-0000/2006),
- 1. Approves the common position as amended;
- 2. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.

Amendments by Parliament

Amendment 1 Article 8, paragraph 2, point (d)

- (d) the financial support to be provided by the Community *in relation to any measure proposed* under Article 4(1) *with a total Community contribution over EUR 200 000*: amounts, duration, distribution and beneficiaries.
- (d) the financial support to be provided by the Community under Article 4(1)(a), first indent (multi-annual cooperation projects): amounts, duration, distribution and beneficiaries.
