DRAFT EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION

on the Council common position for adopting a decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on creating the 'Youth in Action' Programme for the period 2007-2013

(6236/2/2006 - C6-0273/2006 - 2004/0152(COD))

(Codecision procedure: second reading)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Council common position (6236/2/2006 C6-0273/2006),
- having regard to its position at first reading¹ on the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council $(COM(2004)0471)^2$,
- having regard to the amended Commission proposal $(COM(2006)0228)^3$,
- having regard to Article 251(2) of the EC Treaty,
- having regard to Rule 67 of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the recommendation for second reading of the Committee on Culture and Education (A6-0000/2006),
- 1. Approves the common position;
- 2. Notes that the act is adopted in accordance with the common position;
- 3. Instructs its President to sign the act with the President of the Council pursuant to Article 254(1) of the EC Treaty;
- 4. Instructs its Secretary-General to sign the act, once it has been verified that all the procedures have been duly completed, and, in agreement with the Secretary-General of the Council, to have it published in the Official Journal of the European Union;
- 5. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.
