#### c) Detailed grounds for the increase

When adopting the second reading of the 2004 budget, the European Parliament voted an amendment establishing a 'performance facility' for heading 4 by means of the creation of a reserve for administrative and operational expenditure. This reserve aimed at stimulating the performance of the different policy areas, and the credits put in the reserve could be transferred to any line of the policy area concerned in function of the need and utilisation rate, to be justified in the transfer request.

The consumption of the commitment appropriations on line 20.010401 amounted to 64% at the beginning of September. Since the detailed programming for budget line 20.010401 forecasts a complete consumption of the amount of commitment appropriations put forward in the preliminary draft budget, it is considered that the necessary conditions for this request are in place.
