Professor at the School of Public Administration, Rome (1986-1990). Professor of International Law, School of Law, University of Pisa (1980-1996).

Lecturer and Guest Professor in numerous Universities and Institutions abroad (Egypt, France, Germany, Greece, Japan, Latvia, Poland, Russia Federation, U.K., USA).

Fulbright Scholar and Scholar in residence, University of Virginia School of Law (1982-1983); Austin Law School, Texas, (2004-2005); NATO Fellow, 1978 and 1985.

Jean Monnet Fellow, European University Institute (1987-1988); Course at the Hague Academy of International Law (1993).
