

**0248/2021**

**Petition No 0248/2021 by Adrián Fernández Carreño (Spanish), on behalf of the Asociación Salvar El Oliva Beach, on the employment situation at the Hotel Oliva Beach in Fuerteventura.**

The petitioner is a worker and representative of the approximately 400 families involved in the short-time work scheme ‘ERTE’ (‘Expediente de Regulación Temporal de Empleo’) at the Hotel Oliva Beach, and complains that the delay in authorising the renovation and refurbishment of the hotel is preventing the reinstatement of 400 workers. According to the most recent figures from the Canary Islands Institute of Statistics, the unemployment rate at La Oliva is 23.85%, a 70.46% increase compared to January 2020. He also complains that the authorities are not supporting the tourist industry, taking more than three years to grant a building licence that is in the interests of the health and safety of workers. He upholds the right to good administration.

**Recommendations**

- declare admissible;
- ask the Commission for information;
