COMMENTS	<p>During the Christmas break (25th December - 7th January) I concluded a private mission to Niger in order to conclude an on-the-ground analysis and evaluation of the situation in the Sahel and the security and geostrategic implications it poses for the EU. For that purpose, and as it can be inferred from my mission program, I concluded several high-level meetings with key stakeholders.</p> <p>I visited Niamey, Zinder, Diffa (Lake Chad area), Boutti, Djabi and Termit. Given the security concerns inherent in such an itinerary, in which I had to cross complicated deserted areas, during my stay in Diffa I was offered accommodation and an invitation to lunch by the Governor of Diffa at his personal residence. Likewise, when I was visiting Djabi, I was also invited to do an overnight stay at the President's home oasis.</p> <p>For the rest of my trip I stayed either in desert huts (Zinder, Boutti, Termit), and in a hostel in Niamey.</p>
