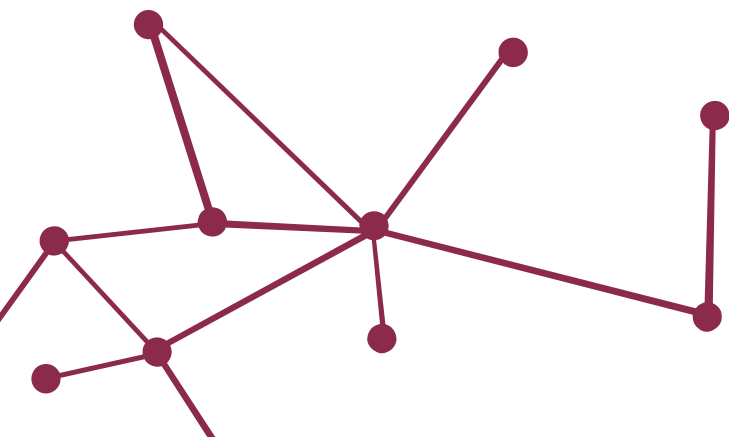
Congress Speakers Agenda
