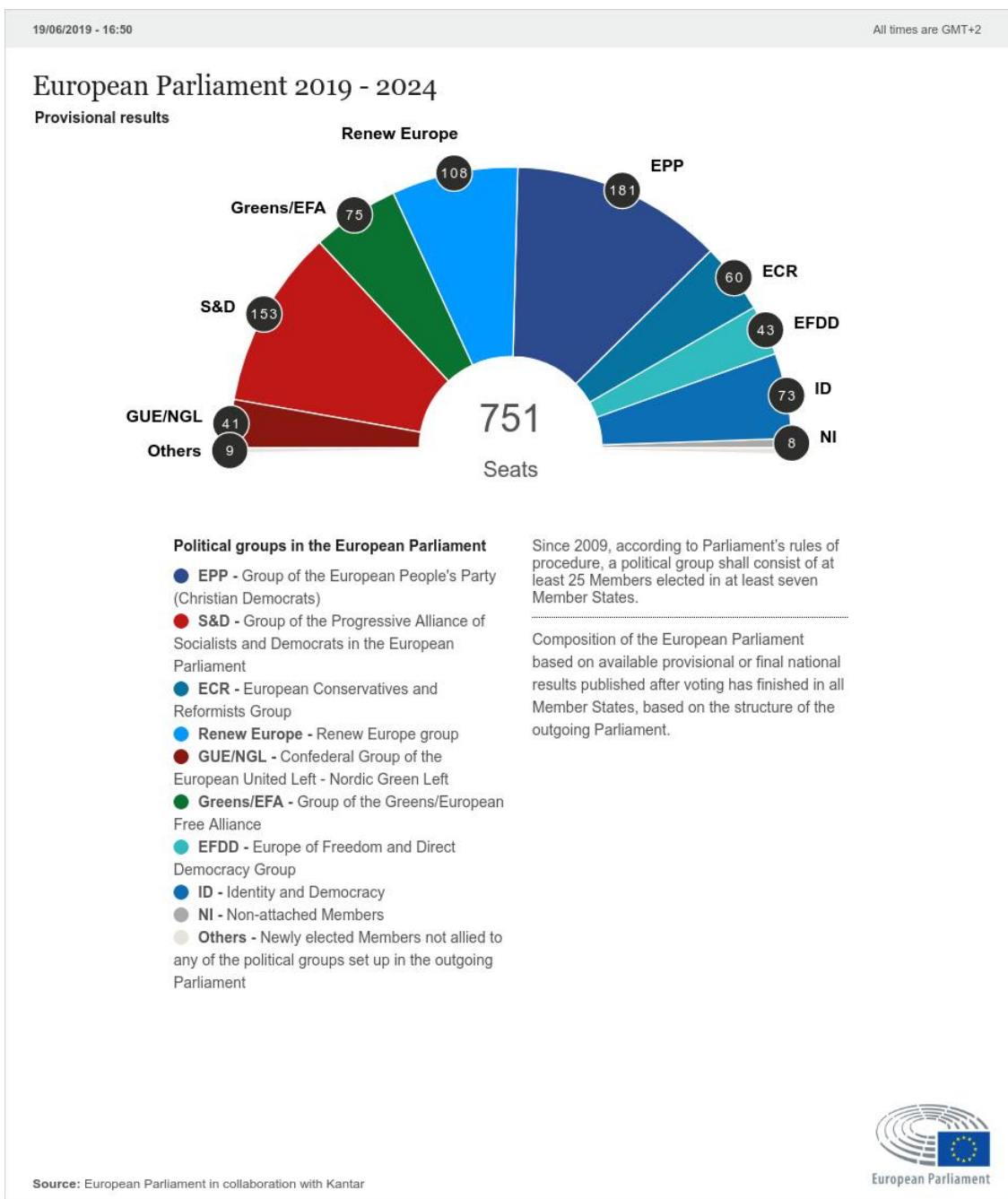




Election 2019: Updated seat projection for new Parliament

New, updated seat projection for the new European Parliament based on official and final results in 28 countries.



Seat distribution (data 20.06.2019)

Seat projections will continue to be updated and published on www.election-results.eu.

This new projection is based on:

- Official results in 11 countries: Austria, Belgium, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Spain
- Final results in 17 countries: Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Netherlands, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden, United Kingdom

On www.election-results.eu you will find national results, seats by political group and country, the breakdown by national parties and political groups, MEPs' gender balance or turnout. You will also be able to compare results, check majorities or upload your widget.

Preliminary turnout figures estimate turnout across the EU at 50.62 % representing a significant increase in participation in the 2019 European elections and the highest turnout for at least the past twenty years.
