Plenary will discuss from 9.00 and vote at 11.30 on legislation requiring EU companies to disclose information that makes it easier for employees to compare salaries. The new rules, already agreed with the Council, foresee sanctions, including fines, for companies that do not comply. A [press conference with the rapporteurs](#) will take place at 12.00.
