On Monday, MEPs met with H.E. Mr Olof Skoog, Ambassador, Head of the EU Delegation to the UN in New York, Commission Vice-President for Values and Transparency Věra Jourová, and with European NGOs to discuss the negotiations of the conclusions of the CSW67.

On Tuesday, MEPs met with H.E. Ms Amina J. Mohammed, UN Deputy Secretary-General, H.E. Maria del Carmen Squeff, Ambassador of Argentina, Vice-Chair designate of the CSW67 and facilitator of the CSW67 conclusions, Hannan Sulieman, UNICEF Deputy Executive Director for Management, Marie Bjerre, Danish Minister for Digitalisation and Gender Equality, Amandeep Singh Gill, UN Envoy on Technology and with European NGOs.

On Wednesday, 8 March, MEPs participated in CSW67 Official Commemoration of International Women's Day. They met with Sima Sami Bahous, UN Under-Secretary-General and UN Women Executive Director, Pramila Patten, Special Representative of the Secretary-General on Sexual Violence in Conflict, Ulrika Modéer, UN Assistant Secretary-General and Director of the Bureau of External Relations and Advocacy, UNDP and EU Youth delegates. MEPs also attended side events taking place in the margins of the conference, with several of them being speakers in these side events.

Finally, on Thursday, MEPs met with House Speaker Emerita Nancy Pelosi and with House Representatives Mary Gay Scanlon and Sheila Jackson Lee. They held a meeting with Katie Keith, Senior Advisor for Health Policy to the Gender Policy Council, and Dr Stephanie Psaki, Director for Global Health Response, National Security Council, from the White House, as well as with Associate Attorney General Vanita Gupta and representatives of civil society.
