Samenvatting On 2 April 2020, as part of the EU response to the needs resulting from the coronavirus outbreak, the European Commission proposed to activate the Emergency Support Instrument and reinforce the Union Civil Protection Mechanism (rescEU). Provision of funding for these measures (€3 billion) requires mobilisation of flexibility and last resort mechanisms available under the 2014-2020 Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF). In order to use the global margin for commitments for this purpose, the Commission proposes to amend the provisions of the MFF Regulation and lift the restrictions on the scope of application of this flexibility mechanism. Consent from the European Parliament for this urgent request is expected to be voted during the 16-17 April plenary session.

Samenvatting This note seeks to provide an initial analysis of the strengths and weaknesses of the European Commission's Impact Assessment (IA) accompanying the Commission proposal for a Regulation on personal protective equipment. This is a proposal to revise Council Directive 89/686/EEC of December 1989 which aims to permit the free movement of personal protective equipment (PPE) in Europe while ensuring a high level of protection for its users against risks. PPE is defined as 'any device or appliance designed to be worn or held by any individual for protection against one or more safety hazards'. It ensures protection against any type of hazards e.g. heat, flames, chemicals, flying particles, mechanical, that may occur in different environments, such as work, home, or leisure, and can protect any part of the human body. This note, prepared by the Ex-Ante Impact Assessment Unit for the Committee on Internal Market and Consumer Protection (IMCO) of the European Parliament, analyses whether the principal criteria laid down in the Commission's own Impact Assessment Guidelines, as well as additional factors identified by the Parliament in its Impact Assessment Handbook, appear to be met by the IA. It does not attempt to deal with the substance of the proposal. It is drafted for informational and background purposes to assist the relevant parliamentary committee(s) and Members more widely in their work.

Samenvatting This report investigates whether there is a conflict between European harmonised legislation covering personal protective equipment at work and the freedom of orthodox Sikhs to practise their religious customs, in particular to wear uncut hair and beards, a comb in the hair knot on top of the head and a Turban for male Sikhs. We found evidence for such a conflict in the UK, where the implementation in national law of the relevant EU directives (DIR 89/656/EEC and 89/686/EEC) resulted in a reversal of a trend in progressive incorporation of a religious exemption from the obligation to wear protective headwear. The conflict appears to be mainly due to the national legislation. The relevant European legislation only prescribes minimum requirements. If the Turban is to be considered as an alternative for bump caps, this may be hampered by the wording of the definition of personal protective equipment in DIR 89/656/EEC, that it has to be designed as such. Several options are presented for EU legislation, administration and policy, concerning safety at work in general and personal protective equipment in particular. We also present options for considering the Turban as an alternative form of head protection.
